"I Hope You Know"

There's something about the Father's hands; unlike ours. When we lift up our own hands in pride; when we come face to face with the moments in life which are our most challenging, human moments, we convince ourselves a little taste won't hurt, a brief encounter won't matter, a silent or secret sin won't wound; when we make the decision to know more about how to live and what is right than God does, we ignore and opportunity to be humble and we squander the power of the Father's hands to lift us up, "that He may exalt you in due time" (I Peter 5:6).

There's something about the Father's hands; unlike ours.
