"I Hope You Know"

"If you want to learn to pray, study the Psalms. If you want to know more about God, study the Psalms. If you want to know more about divine revelation, study the Psalms. If you want to know more about how to worship, study the Psalms. If your broken heart is seeking comfort, study the Psalms."

Scripture is so distinct from all other works of literary endeavors. Its nature is divine, its reach to the soul is eternal, and its theme is singular, "Jesus, the Christ." When upon the eve of Christianity's explosion across the world, Jesus confirmed this truth, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me" (Luke 24:44). Scripture points to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and in turn, calls us to see Him in all that our Lord has revealed to us.

No small part of the testimony concerning our Lord and Savior is preserved in the book of Psalms. In his book, "Finding the Old Testament in the New," Henry M. Shires had made an extensive study of the Old Testament as revealed in the New Testament. Particularly, regarding the book of Psalms, there were several noteworthy observations. Some of his conclusions yielded the following information: "The New Testament quotes directly from the Psalms 70 times. 60 quotations are made without direct reference.



There are 220 other passages containing identifiable citations and phrases from the Psalms, for a total of 350 citations in the New Testament from the book of Psalms alone. 500 of the 2,450 verses from Psalms are seen in the New Testament. Passages from 120 of the 150 Psalms are found in the N.T."

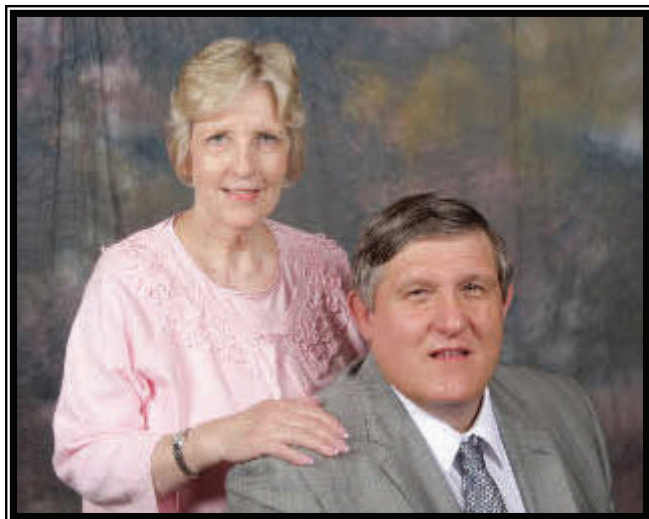
When the heart is in rhythm with the Psalms, (the words which so often were written as an outlet through the storms of life), it cannot help but beat with the truth of Christ's nature (Psalm 45:6-7), His rejection (Psalm 118:22-23), His suffering and death (Psalm 22), His resurrection (Psalm 16:8-10), and His reign and Lord supreme (Psalm 2:7-8).

Hope is our promise in Jesus. Faith is our lens through which we see the promise. Love is our bond for here and the hereafter (I Corinthians 13:13). Beginning this Sunday morning and through the month of April, we will look to our "Jesus in the Psalms." I hope you know how blessed we are by His greatness and how greatly blessed we will be when we seek to see Him more and more throughout the precious message of God's love, the Bible.
